- Currently NRP PAC has \$19,000 in our Gaming Account from September 2019 and is about to apply for the next Gaming Grant (funds will arrive by October 2019). Approximate value of that will be \$17,000
- After meeting with some PAC Executives and a parent we have come up with a list of proposed expenditures for discussion and voting on:

**MOTION:** Jeanine Rhemtulla made motion “Motion to approve paying for all eligible 2018/2019 PAC expenditures from the Gaming Grant including Spring Fair, Multicultural Day, 7/8 Leaving Ceremony, and reimbursing NRP for moneys paid out by them for Club Competitions”.

**MOTION:** Jeanine Rhemtulla made the motion “Motion to allocate \$6,000 of current Gaming Grant funds for ‘Small Grants for Extra-curricular Clubs’ and create a simple application process whereby extra-curricular club sponsors can apply for support for club resources and activities.

The next motion is where we would like approval from PAC to open a broader discussion around how NRP PAC can effectively use our Gaming Grant funds. Spending of the funds are highly restrictive. The PAC Executives feel we have an opportunity to make a positive change but recognize this may mean pushing the boundaries of “legitimate” gaming grant spending.

**MOTION:** Jeanine Rhemtulla mad motion “Motion to begin a broader conservation on other innovative ways in which we could use Gaming Grant funds to improve the student experience. Set aside funds (approx \$6K, see proposed budget) in anticipation of such expenditures.”

## **School Report:**

Update provided on the following topics:

- **Clubs** currently running at NRP including Paint your Lunch, Sci Fi, Grad gym, Middle school Choir, Track and Field, Robotics and Diversity Club
- Artwork in the main hall include shavings from the totem pole currently being carved at the VSB main office on Broadway.
- Grade 4 and 7`s will be completing a Student Learning Survey. It is a social/emotional survey. Staff will also complete a survey and parents are being asked to fill one out as well.
- April 11: Ready, Set, Learn: a group of age 3 and 4 children came to the school to watch a performance in the gym
- April 20th was Welcome to K Event. Almost 100 kids and their parents participated
- NRP hosted 140 staff at the last ProD Day. Topic was on Inquiry Learning
- Camps coming for Grade 4, 6, 7 and 8`s
- Volunteer Tea happening May 13th. All parents who volunteer in the school are invited.
- Sports Day will be broken up this year like last year
- Terry Fox run is Tuesday May 7th
- Leaving Ceremony for the Grade 7 and 8`s will be June 25th. More info coming
- Staffing: Administration will find out about staffing levels this Friday
  - anticipating there will be 32 divisions next year including 5 K Classes
  - 8 Staff leaving - announcements will happen later
- Next year K-7 will have no Explorations (since we are losing the Grade 8`s). NRP will keep Foods and Music for older students and likely Music and Library or Digital Media for the younger students.
